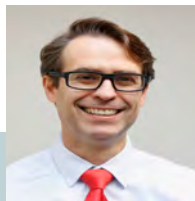

**Ewa Czochrowska, DDS, PhD**  
Warsaw, Poland  
*“Tooth Transplantation”*  
*“The Orthodontic  
Periodontal Interface”*

Dr. Czochrowska graduated from the Dental Faculty in Warsaw, Poland, in 1991. She finished a postgraduate training in orthodontics at the University in Oslo, Norway, in 1997, then worked as a Research Fellow at the Orthodontic Department Dental Faculty in Oslo until 2002.

In 2003, she was awarded a PhD from the University in Oslo for a thesis on autotransplantation of teeth. For the publication from this work, she received the American Journal of Orthodontics and Dentofacial Orthopedics Helen E. Dewel Orthodontic Award in 2002. In March 2013, she was awarded a Habilitation Degree from the University of Warsaw, Poland.

At present, Dr. Czochrowska is working at the Department of Orthodontics, Medical University and in private practice in Warsaw.



**Marcio Almeida, DDS, MSc, PhD**  
Londrina, Paraná, Brazil  
*“Facial & Smile Esthetics”*

Dr. Almeida maintains a private orthodontic practice in Bauru, São Paulo, Brazil since 1994. He received his MSc, PhD and Post-doctorate from the University of São Paulo, Bauru Dental School. He is a Full Professor at University of North Paraná, UNOPAR, Londrina-PR, Brazil.

Dr. Almeida's main focus of research is on Class II treatment, Biomechanics, Open Bite, Deep Bite, Root Resorption and Skeletal Anchorage.

He has published more than 120 peer reviewed clinical and scientific articles and has published a book on Clinical Orthodontics and Biomechanics.

Dr. Marcio serves as a reviewer for the AJODO, Angle Orthodontist, Journal of Orthodontics, Acta Odontologica Scandinavica, Progress in Orthodontics, Dental Press Journal of Orthodontics, Revista clínica Dental Press, Ortodontia SPO, European Journal of Pediatric Dentistry and several others. He is also a member of the editorial board of the Journal of the World Federation of Orthodontists and an active member of Angle Society (North Atlantic Component).



**Dr. Björn Ludwig**  
Traben-Trarbach, Germany

Dr. Ludwig maintains a private orthodontic practice in Traben-Trarbach, Germany. He is an Assistant Professor at the University of Homburg/Saar, Department of Orthodontics.

Dr. Ludwig's focus of research is skeletal anchorage and 3D imaging. He has published more than 100 peer reviewed clinical and scientific articles, and is editor of three books. He is editor in chief of the Quintessenz publication “Kieferorthopädie” (Orthodontics). He is also co-editor of the Journal of Clinical Orthodontics.

Dr. Ludwig is an active member of the Angle Society of Europe and serves on the council of the German Board of Orthodontics.



**Takashi Ono, DDS, PhD**  
Tokyo, Japan  
*“Treatment of High Class II

Experience at Tokyo Medical  
& Dental University”*

Dr. Ono is Professor and Chairman of Department of Orthodontic Science, Tokyo Medical and Dental University (TMDU) Graduate School, Tokyo, Japan. He is also Vice Dean of TMDU Dental Hospital.

From 1991 to 1994, he studied and worked at the University of British Columbia, Vancouver, Canada. From 2000 to 2001, he studied at the University of Copenhagen, Denmark. Professor Ono also works as an Adjunct/Visiting Professor at 3 domestic and 3 international universities.

In addition, Dr. Ono serves as an editorial board member for 6 international peer-reviewed journals. He has published 6 book chapters and more than 210 scientific articles. He is currently a member of the Executive Committee of the World Federation of Orthodontists (WFO), and has been appointed as Chairman of the 9th International Orthodontic Congress (IOC) in Yokohama, Japan in 2020.
